Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your correspondence of 3 December 2015 requesting the European Court of Human Rights under Rule 39 of the Rules of Court to stop your imprisonment or order your release from prison.

This application falls outside the scope of Rule 39 and therefore has not been submitted to a judge for decision. The Court will, therefore, not stop you imprisonment or order your release from prison.

The Court applies Rule 39 only where an applicant faces an imminent risk of serious and irreparable damage. The vast majority of cases in which Rule 39 is applied concern deportation and extradition proceedings and involve complaints that the applicant will be at real risk of a violation of Article 2 (the right to life) or Article 3 (the right not to be subjected to torture or inhuman treatment) of the Convention, if sent to the destination State.

You will be informed in due course about future procedure.


